  4. Juvenile Pleasure (ages 17 & under – walk, pleasure gait, no back-up)
  5. Walk Only (any age, any breed, escorts permitted)
  6. Juvenile Western (walk, jog, back-up)
  7. Open Pleasure – English Tack (walk, trot)
  8. Juvenile Gaited Pleasure (walk, pleasure gait, back-up)
  9. Adult Western (walk, jog, back-up)
  10. Trail Pleasure Racking (no pads or action devices – walk, slow rack, back-up)
  11. Old Timers (ages 50 & older – walk, pleasure gait, no back-up)
  12. Pony Class (52” and under – walk, pleasure gait, no back-up)
  13. Show Pleasure Walking (with pads – flat walk, running walk, no canter)
  14. Adult Western Pleasure (walk, jog, lope, back-up)
  15. Adult Gaited Pleasure (walk, jog, lope, back-up)
  16. Kids Class (12 & under – walk, pleasure gait, no back-up)
- Intermission – CAKE WALK, HORSE CAKE WALK, AND STICK HORSE RACE**
17. Trail Obstacle
  18. Novice Class (neither horse, nor rider has ever won a blue ribbon – walk, pleasure gait)
  19. Style Racking (no pads or action devices – show walk, style rack)
  20. Ladies Gaited Pleasure (walk, pleasure gait)
  21. Open Walking (with pads – flat walk, running walk)
  22. Men's Gaited (walk, pleasure gait)
  23. Country Gaited Pleasure (no pads or action devices – walk, pleasure gait, back-up)
  24. Plantation Pleasure Specialty (no pads/action devices – flat walk, running walk, no canter)
  25. Open Club Members (walk, pleasure gait)
  26. Exhibition Poles (3 runs per horse)
  27. Juvenile Poles (1 run per horse)
  28. Open Poles (1 run per horse)
  29. Exhibition Speed (3 runs per horse)
  30. Juvenile Speed (1 run per horse)
  31. Open Speed (1 run per horse)
  32. Exhibition Barrels (3 runs per horse)
  33. Juvenile Barrels (1 run per horse)
  34. Open Barrels (1 run per horse)
